

points of interest

- > **Community Centre** is located at the Recreation Reserve and has excellent facilities for small and large events.
- > Lake Albacutya is usually dry and adjoins Wyperfeld National Park. Access is via the sealed road from Yaapeet (14kms) to the main camping area, Yaapeet Beach. O.T.I.T. Camping Ground is also another scenic bush camp for travellers. Some tracks are 4WD only. No camping fees apply.
- > **Paradise Flora and Fauna Reserve** is suitable for 4WD drive access only. This sandy camp area is set amongst native scrubland. Facilities include a fire pit and park bench.
- > **Turkey Bottom Ponds** are located behind the Information Centre in Byrne Street and are filled by storm water. The ponds provide water for wildlife.
- > Wyperfeld National Park is the perfect location for nature and desert walks, discovering wildlife, two and four wheel driving, cycling and motorbike riding. Wonga Campground is a popular camping spot and facilities include an Information Centre, shelters and amenities. Fees apply.
- > Yaapeet Camping Ground is located at the Recreation Reserve and is complete with powered and non powered sites, amenities, tennis courts, BBQ, playground and a 'Chop Shed' is also available with open fire place and cooking facilities. The camping ground is a great location to kick back and relax with family and friends.
